Terry Dean and Gary Carruthers are major players in Melbourne's live music scene. These boys are reputed to have single-handedly transformed duo-based live music to previously unheard of levels of popularity and earning power.

These skills also keep the pair in demand for recording sessions and live instrumental/vocal backing with other artists such as Kasey Chambers.
